CONVERSION OF YOUR FOREIGN DRIVING LICENCE

Have you obtained permanent residency and is the holder of a foreign driving licence?

According to the National Road Traffic Act, 1996 of South Africa you have to convert your foreign driving licence within 5 years from obtaining your permanent residency or resuming your residency in South Africa.



REQUIRED DOCUMENTS FOR CONVERSION

- Permanent Residency Certificate;
- Passport;
- Foreign Driving Licence;
- Confirmation Letter;
- SA identity document (if in possession of one) or Traffic Register Number Certificate or a Foreign Identity Document.

These documents must be presented to the Driving Licence Helpdesk of the Department of Transport for permission to convert a foreign driving licence.
